With scope 3 representing 77% of the chemical industry's emissions, this topic is crucial on our pathway to a more sustainable future. Companies in our industry are at the forefront of developing and implementing solutions for tracking, managing, and ultimately reducing scope 3. To foster this progress, essenscia's workshop unites people deeply involved in leading the change to inspire and support each other for more rapid advancement.

The workshop starts with an update on the latest policies, followed by an overview of tfs' guideline developments. After a coffee break, Beaulieu will share about their long-term transformation journey to reduce the total emissions of their complete value chain by at least 42% by 2030. Subsequently, we will learn about AJBio-Pharma's Aji Eco Passport, a tool developed in-house, measuring the carbon footprint per production process step with the purpose to engage with customers on identifying measures to reduce the carbon footprint of contributing factors (e.g. solvents, precious metals). Finally, a guided discussion shall serve to further deepen the topic and expand to accounts of other companies represented by the experts present. The workshop will be closed with a walking lunch.
